The Associate Dean responsible for International Education oversees the award program. The funds have been made available from The College of Education Global Initiatives Fund.

Eligibility:

Each candidate for the Global Initiatives Scholarship must:

- Be an undergraduate or graduate College of Education major
 - Undergraduate majors: Early Childhood Education, Elementary Education, Bilingual/Bicultural Elementary Education, Middle Level Education, SED DHH, SED LBS1, SED LVB
 - o Graduate majors: One of the majors listed on the <u>COE website</u>.
- Be accepted to participate in one of the study abroad programs sponsored and developed by the College of Education
- Be a first-time international traveler
- Demonstrate financial need
- Award winners agree to write an article for the College of Education website summarizing their study abroad experiences
