



In this role, she assesses potential barriers and develops strategies focused on recruiting and retaining a diverse underrepresented student population and designs training initiatives on cultural competency, gender differences, disability, and sexual orientation designed to increase awareness and support of equity and inclusion values, while maintaining compliance with applicable laws. Adrienne is also a nationally recognized speaker and founding consultant of Candid Conversations Matter, a company created to advance diversity, equity, and inclusion work. As a consultant, she has assisted educational institutions, social-service organizations, law enforcement, government agencies, and international groups.




